## Summer Intensive Japanese Language

The Summer Intensive Language program allows students to immerse themselves in Japanese life while studying a year's worth of college-level Japanese in one summer.

### 10 credits of intensive Japanese language in four levels (beginner to advanced)

Daily instruction addresses listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Placement is based on exams held at the beginning of the program.

### Japanese cultural experiences, including field trips and weekly culture classes

Learn about Japanese calligraphy, flower arranging, martial arts, and more. Visit famous historical sites in the *kansai* region on JCMU-arranged field trips.

### Opportunities to engage with the community

Practice Japanese with conversation partners, stay with a host family, and participate in club activities at local universities and community events on JCMU campus and beyond!

All students are provided with housing in the JCMU residence hall and may apply to live with a host family (pending availability). More information about housing can be found on the JCMU website.
