- *JCMU Consortium institutions include all 15 public Michigan universities: Central Michigan University, Eastern Michigan University, Ferris State University, Grand Valley State University, Lake Superior State University, Michigan State University, Michigan Technological University, Northern Michigan University, Oakland University, Saginaw Valley State University, The University of Michigan (UM - Ann Arbor, UM - Dearborn, UM - Flint), Wayne State University, and Western Michigan University
- **After admission, JCMU will provide details of a recommended flight. For travel to JCMU, students may opt to join a chaperoned group (with most costs included) or may make their own arrangements (at their own cost). If students opt to make their own arrival arrangements for travel to JCMU, estimated costs could increase.
- ***JCMU-arranged homestay placements have a required application process and are contingent upon the availability of an appropriate host family placement in the local area (travel totaling 60 minutes or less door-to-door, each way).
