<p>Food (estimated) All apartments in the JCMU Residence Hall feature a kitchen with cooking utensils and appliances. JCMU campus features an onsite restaurant (but does not have a dining hall). This estimate is based on ~\$30 / day, which is sufficient for eating several meals out. Preparing meals at JCMU can reduce this estimate significantly.</p>	\$650
<p>Additional Costs / Misc. Expenses (estimated) Independent travel, entertainment, gifts, etc. Actual expenses can vary greatly from student to student based on personal spending habits and current exchanges rates. Estimated at ~\$75 / week.</p>	\$250
