Program & Housing Fee Includes tuition, course materials, international travel health insurance, and program- sponsored field trips/activities. Continuous housing will be provided in the JCMU Residence Hall, hotels/other lodging (if applicable), or a combination of both (as outlined in the final program itinerary).	\$4,500

Airfare – Recommended Flight (estimated) Students are responsible for making their own travel arrangements. Details of a recommended flight will be provided after acceptance to the program, but students may opt for other flights (which might be more or less expensive).	\$2,400
Ground Transportation (estimated) Based on travel from the program ending location (as indicated in the final program itinerary) to Tokyo Haneda (HND); Travel to/from other airports might be more or less expensive. Also includes an estimate of luggage shipment, if recommended.	\$40
Food (estimated) All apartments in the JCMU Residence Hall feature a kitchen with cooking utensils and appliances. JCMU campus features an onsite restaurant (but does not have a dining hall). This estimate is based on ~\$30 / day, which is sufficient for eating several meals out.  Preparing meals at JCMU can reduce this estimate significantly.	\$600
Additional Costs / Misc. Expenses (estimated) Independent travel, entertainment, gifts, etc. Actual expenses can vary greatly from student to student based on personal spending habits and current exchanges rates. Estimated at ~\$55 / week.	\$250
